Code of Ethics

Statement I

A Pharmacist, Certified dispenser or Registered student shall hold the health and safety of each patient to be of primary consideration.

Statement II

A Pharmacist, Certified dispenser or Registered student shall form a professional relationship with each patient.

Statement III

A Pharmacist, Certified dispenser or Registered student shall honour the autonomy, values and dignity of each patient.

Statement IV

A Pharmacist, Certified dispenser or Registered student shall respect and protect the patient's right of confidentiality.

Statement V

A Pharmacist, Certified dispenser or Registered student shall respect the rights of patients to receive pharmacy products and services and ensure these rights are met.

Statement VI

A Pharmacist, Certified dispenser or Registered student shall observe the law, preserve high professional standards and uphold the dignity and honour of the profession.

Statement VII

A Pharmacist, Certified dispenser or Registered student shall continually improve their levels of professional knowledge and skills.

Statement VIII

A Pharmacist, Certified dispenser or Registered student shall cooperate with colleagues and other health care professionals so that maximum benefits to patient care can be realized.

Statement IX

A Pharmacist, Certified dispenser or Registered student shall contribute to the health care system and to societal health needs.
